



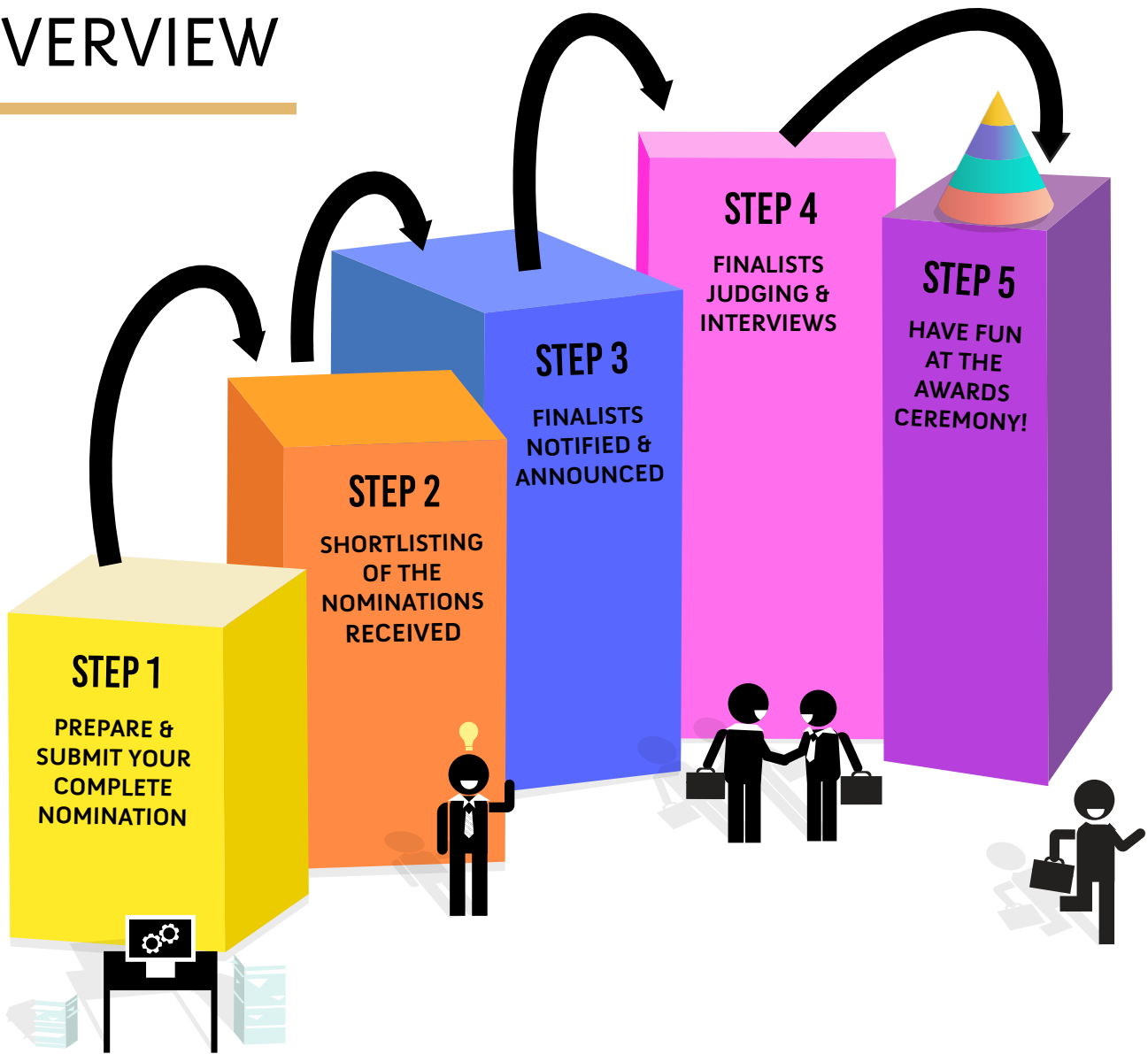

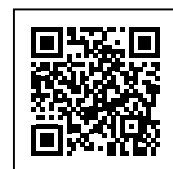
1. You are a permanent resident of Australia and reside in the NT.

3. The nomination in its entirety has been completed by you.
4. The nomination is endorsed by your employer (if applicable).
5. The nomination is endorsed by your Registered Training Organisation (if applicable).
6. Be prepared to sign a talent release.
7. You have photos and digital copies of certificates, awards etc. ready to attach to your nomination.
8. You and your employer acknowledge if shortlisted you must be available to attend the judging process.
9. You and your employer acknowledge should you be a finalist, you must be available to attend the GTNT Group Awards Ceremony on Friday, 6 June 2025.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All nominees will need to read and agree to the Conditions of Entry prior to submitting their nomination.
- The closing time and date for all nominations is 10pm, 31 January 2025. No nomination will be accepted after this date.
- All nominees must complete a nomination form and answer all criteria. You may ask your Employment Specialist for assistance in completing your nomination.
- Nominees must meet all other eligibility criteria.
- **Nominees for individual categories must be employed or managed by GTNT Group.**
- Nominees must agree to abide by the decision of the judging panel, which is final and cannot be appealed.
- Finalists must agree for their photographs, profiles and training details to be used for promotional purposes by GTNT Group and their host business.
- Finalists must be prepared to make a short video for use on the night.
- Finalists must be prepared to be involved in promotional events and activities if required.
- Finalists must be available for the judging interview, filming and GTNT Group Awards Night. (refer to key dates)
- Winners of individual categories must be prepared to present a short speech upon receiving their award.

Winners of selected categories may go on to submit for the same category at the NT Training Awards. Your Employment Specialist will contact you to discuss your nomination and the event details prior to the event in late August 2025.

- Completing/completed a Certificate II or above qualification through an Australian School-based apprenticeship or traineeship between 1 July 2024 and 30 June 2025.
- Must have a Training Contract registered with the NT Training Authority – Apprenticeships NT.

- Must have commenced their apprenticeship/traineeship in the Prelude to the Future 6 Program
- Must have completed Stage 1 (26 week milestone) of the program.

- Open to any female apprentice or trainee at any stage of their training, currently working within the construction industry.
